CROWN MY YEAR

PRAYER POINTS FOR THE WEEK

Psalms 65:11-13 (NLT) You crown the year with a bountiful harvest; even the hard pathways overflow with abundance. 12 The grasslands of the wilderness become a lush pasture, and the hillsides blossom with joy. 13 The meadows are clothed with flocks of sheep, and the valleys are carpeted with grain. They all shout and sing for joy!

- 1. In the same way a head is encircled.
 - a. Pray that your year would be encircled with God's goodness
 - b. Pray that even the paths that seem to be hard will be encircled with an overflow of abundance.
- 2. Crown symbolises authority usually made of or decorated with precious metals
 - a. Pray that this year you receive, operate and be crowned with authority over sickness, diseases, principalities and powers. God has given you authority. Luke 10:19 (NKJV) Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
 - Pray that God will decorate you and fill your life with precious things in the name of Jesus.
 - c. Pray that God will crown you with wisdom and knowledge to fill your life in 2024 with precious and valuable things in the name of Jesus. *Proverbs 24:3-4 (NLT) A house is built by wisdom and becomes strong through good sense. 4 Through knowledge its rooms are filled with all sorts of precious riches and valuables.*
- A crown is placed on the topmost part of the body, so that everyone can see from any direction.
 - a. Declare that In 2024 you would be on top and not at the bottom.
 - b. Pray that you would adhere to and obey all the rules to keep this crown in Jesus
 name. *Deuteronomy 28:13 (NLT) If you listen to these commands of the LORD*

your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the LORD will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom.

- 4. To crown is to declare someone a champion.
 - a. Declare that this year you would operate like champion all through 2024
 - b. Pray that you would experience victory and you would not be defeated in Jesus name. Romans 8:37 (TPT) Yet even in the midst of all these things, we triumph over them all, for God has made us to be more than conquerors, and his demonstrated love is our glorious victory over everything!
- 5. To be Crowned is to be Empowered. It gives one self-worth, self-confidence, Self-care.
 - a. God will crown you with the empowerment of abundance and goodness and everything else. Philippians 4:13 (AMP) 13 I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency].
